How it's assessed	Written exam: 1 hour 45 minutes • 64 marks • 40% of GCSE Section A Shakespeare: students will answer one question on their play (<i>Macbeth</i>). They will be required to write in detail about an extract from the play and then to write about the play as a whole. Section B The 19th-century novel: students will answer one question on their novella (<i>A Christmas Carol</i>). They will be required to write in detail about an extract from the novella and then to write about the novella as a whole.
Paper 2	Modern texts and poetry An Inspector Calls Poetry Anthology: Power and Conflict (15 poems) Unseen poetry
How it's assessed	Written exam: 2 hour 15 minutes • 96 marks • 60% of GCSE Section A Modern texts: students will answer one essay question from a choice of two on their studied modern prose or drama text (An Inspector Calls) Section B Poetry: students will answer one comparative question on one named poem printed on the paper and one other poem from their chosen anthology cluster (Power and Conflict) Section C Unseen poetry: Students will answer one longer question on the first unseen poem and one shorter question comparing this poem with a second unseen poem.
