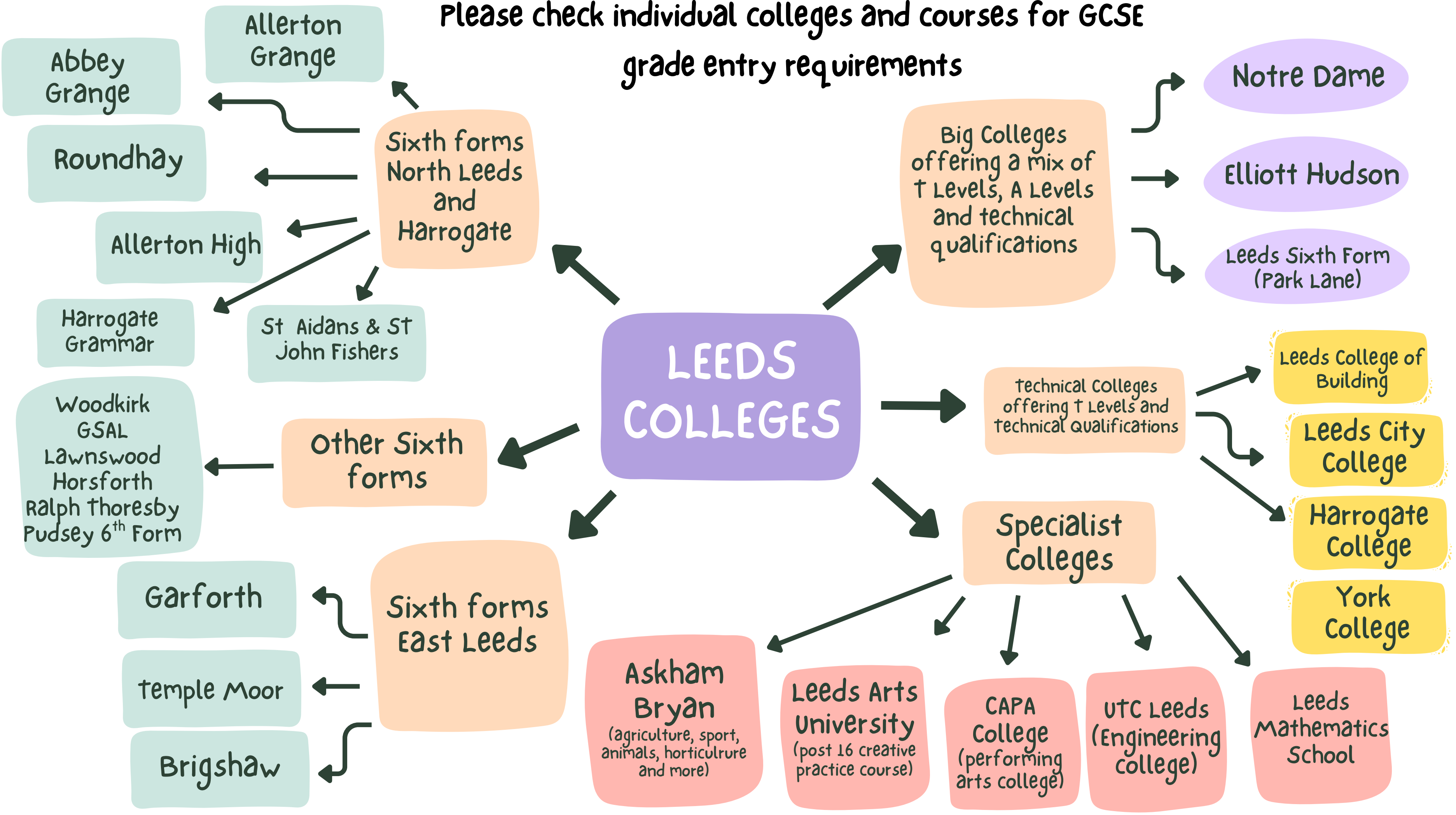

Lighthouse Futures Trust

Lighthouse Futures Trust is a specialist college in Headingley for young adults, aged 16-25, who experience diverse challenges and barriers. Their purpose is to prepare them to be independent in life and develop skills that enable them to enter the world of work. They do this by offering bespoke pathways that empower them to build confidence, skills and knowledge.



Future Horizons South and West Leeds Sites

Specialist education programmes for those continuing on their learning journey and have an EHCP in place. These college courses are offered for three years.

PINC College

The curriculum focuses on Art Design and Craft attainment and qualifications, with English and Maths where applicable. Functional skills such as English, Maths, Communication and ICT are embedded throughout each individual study programme. Engage is their full-time creative learning framework, giving access to level 2 and 3 qualifications, over 1 or 2 years, with work experience in the cultural and creative sectors. There is a final-year option for a Supported Internship. Link programmes are available to support transition pre-enrolment.

Leeds City College



Joseph Priestly Centre

Supports students 16 to 25 years old with mild to moderate learning and physical disabilities with EHCPs. In preparation for adulthood and independent living, they are a 3 day provision offering students independent living skills, work skills, English, Maths, Community pathway days, health and wellbeing and culinary skills.



Somerville House

Provides a diverse range of amenities, tailored for learners aged 16 to 25 who are keen on enhancing their personal development and employability skills alongside English and Maths.



Temple Newsam Home Farm

Offers hands-on practical understanding of raising farm animals and observing wildlife at the Temple Newsam Campus, located on the picturesque Home Farm. Courses cover multiple principles and practices of animal care across domestic animals and wildlife. Students can expect to gain management knowledge as well as practical experience with grooming and caring. A great opportunity to experience one of Europe's largest working rare breed farms, students will also have access to the animal care centre, which is home to small mammals and exotic animals.



Swarthmore Education Centre

Swarthmore is a centre for lifelong learning, community projects and family learning sessions as well as courses and activities. Swarthmore Study Programme is for young people ages 16-25 who have additional support needs and an EHCP. The Programme offers the opportunity for individualised, flexible learning plans. The focus is on providing a general education and using a broad range of learning opportunities to improve English and maths skills, with the aim of preparing students for employment or further training. Young people who are nearing the end of their time in education can join our supported Preparation for Progression programme. This programme concentrates more heavily on work experience, independence skills and applying for jobs, further or higher education, or volunteering.



West SILC - Powerhouse

The Powerhouse Life-Changing (PLC) Pathway is a forward-thinking, inclusive Post-16 curriculum designed to support young people on their journey to adulthood. Rooted in the values of empowerment, independence, dignity, and holistic growth, the programme is built around two integrated strands: 'Learning to Live', which develops essential life skills such as personal care, budgeting, communication, and emotional regulation, and 'Learning to Earn', which prepares learners for employment through vocational training, work placements, and entrepreneurial experiences.
