Allerton Grange partners up for the next phase of school improvement

Since 2020 we have been committed to delivering an exceptional quality of education through our KLAS (Knowledge, Literacy, Aspirational Enrichment and Social Mobility) curriculum model. We continue to work on ensuring that KLAS is delivered securely and consistently in every area of the school.

This year there are two priorities that we are focusing on to achieve this ambition:

1. Developing students' oracy skills

We have partnered up with the national charity "Voice 21", who work with over 600 schools across the country. By becoming a Voice 21 Oracy School, Allerton Grange is committed to transform oracy teaching and learning across our school, enabling all students to access and benefit from a high-quality oracy education. Teachers will receive bespoke training and, as a result, we will support students in speaking more accurately and confidently about the knowledge and experiences they are gaining at Allerton Grange. Staff receive their first training on this priority next Friday (23 September).

2. Narrowing the knowledge and word gap for disadvantaged students

The pandemic widened the knowledge and word gap between disadvantaged students and their peers. The ambition at Allerton Grange is that all students, regardless of background or ability, can access our highly ambitious KLAS curriculum. Too many students lack the prior knowledge, the cultural capital and the bank of vocabulary that allows them to fully access our curriculum and so Allerton Grange is joining forces with Huntington Research School and Leeds City Council to develop effective strategies to narrow this gap.
