Many salons offer full-time apprenticeships for school leavers.

College – Complete your hairdressing or beauty training at The Print Works.

University – Such as; Special Make-Up Effects for Film and Television BDes (Hons)

WHEN YOU'VE QUALIFIED – CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS

Owner – Of your own Hair salon or Beauty salon

Hotels – Working in a hair or beauty salon in a hotel.

Sports centre/Spa – Working in a hair and/or beauty salon at a sports centre or Spa.

Theatre – Hair, make up and aesthetics for theatre shows.

Media – Hair & Make up for magazine photo shoots

Film & Television – Hair & Make up for actors and actresses for the film and television

Sales Representative – Working as a rep' for companies such as L'Oréal, GHD, Rimmel, Mac.

Store assistant – Working on a beauty counter in places such as Boots, Debenhams, Harvey Nicholls.

Cruise – Working on a cruise, travelling the world as a hairdresser/beautician.

Prison – Working in a prison doing the prisoners hair or teaching prisoners hairdressing & beauty skills.

Funeral parlour –Preparing the deceased for private viewing.

Teacher/Tutor – Working in a college, salon, school teaching students hairdressing or beauty.

Freelance – Working for yourself as a mobile hairdresser or beautician which can include Bridal hairdressing and Mendhi.

Hospital/Care homes – Many hospitals and care homes require hairdressers to tend to patients who may have a serious illness. Our ageing population living in care homes also require visits from hair & beauty professionals.
