OUR VALUES




Integrity: Our actions are consistent, based on a deep commitment and courage to always do the right thing for the right reason. This will always be in the best interest of the school.

OUR WAY OF WORKING




At Allerton Grange, we challenge ourselves to continually improve and grow as a staff community.
