Re: Year 7 Bushcraft Trip: Wednesday 1 to Friday 3 July 2026

We are pleased to inform you that our three-day residential trip for Year 7 students is returning. The trip will be held at **The Bushcraft Company site at Castle Howard, North Yorkshire** on **Wednesday 1 to Friday 3 July 2026**. This is an exciting, outdoor experience, which offers students the opportunity to step beyond the classroom, build lasting friendships, and develop key skills such as leadership, teamwork, and problem-solving in a unique and memorable setting.

Bushcraft offers a truly authentic camping adventure, encouraging resilience and independence removed from home comforts. Students will be without electronic devices and other modern distractions, relying instead on the essentials: a tent, a sleeping bag, cooking over an open fire—and basic toilet facilities, with no access to electricity or showers. We will have exclusive use of a woodland camp where students can develop valuable skills and knowledge beyond the classroom. For students considering the Duke of Edinburgh Award, this is an excellent introductory experience.

Some activities that your child will be able to experience on the Bushcraft trip are:

- Constructing a shelter from natural materials (with the option to sleep in it!)
- First aid training and applying skills in a dramatic role-play scenario
- Foraging and learning essential wild cooking techniques
- Camouflage and concealment games to develop awareness and observation skills

The total cost of the trip is expected to be approximately **£240 per student**. This will be confirmed once final numbers are known. The cost includes:

- Tent accommodation for two nights
- All meals and snacks over the three days
- Coach travel to and from the Castle Howard site
- A full programme of activities with all instruction, supervision, and equipment provided





















We have secured approximately 190 places for this trip. To confirm your child's interest, please return the attached consent form by **Monday 29 September 2025** to the main office. If demand exceeds the number of places available, names will be selected via a random draw. A waiting list will also be created for any additional interest.

Once places are confirmed, we will contact you with either an option to pay in full or a detailed payment schedule, paid via Parent Pay. This will begin with a £50 deposit due in November 2025, followed by six, monthly non-refundable payments of approximately £31, concluding in May 2026. Please note, if the schedule deadlines are not met, your child will be removed from the trip.

There will be a Parent Information Evening held in the main hall on Thursday 2 April 2026, where we will share further details about logistics, expectations, and answer any questions you may have.
