Communication Plan in the event of School Closure

As we approach the winter months, I want to ensure that everyone is clear on the procedures we will follow in the event of severe weather, such as snow, which may impact the safe opening of the school.

Key Procedures

Safety First: The decision to close the school will only be made if conditions pose a significant risk to students and staff.

Assessment: We will monitor local weather reports and assess site safety early each morning.

Communication Strategy

Notification Time: If the school needs to close, we will communicate this decision as early as possible and no later than 8:00am.

How We Will Inform You

ClassCharts: A message will be sent directly to all parents/carers.

School Website: A notice will be posted on the homepage.

Additional Updates: If conditions worsen during the day, we will update you promptly using the same channels.

Footwear Guidance

In the event that the school remains open during snowy or icy conditions, we will confirm suitable footwear options as part of our communication. This will ensure students can move around the site safely and comfortably.

Remote Learning

If the school is closed due to severe weather, all work for the day will be set via ClassCharts. Students should check their accounts regularly and complete the tasks provided by their teachers to ensure learning continues uninterrupted.
