Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Examination remark process

We are confident that the examination boards we use, have a robust system of marking students' GCSE and A-Level examinations. In the unlikely case students feel that a result in a subject is inaccurate, there is a process by which you can have this investigated further.

When students collect their results from school on results day in August 2026, they can sign a consent form, allowing us to access scripts. This permission must come from the student.

We would not recommend requesting sending your paper for a review of marking unless they are 3 marks away from the next grade boundaries. You can find grade boundaries online via the exam board websites. Please be aware that grades can go down as well as up and the grade after the review of marking will be the final grade.

The family of the student is also responsible for the payment of the remark. The costs are charged by paper not by qualification. For example, if you wanted to send all three GCSE Math papers you would be charged three times the review of marking fee. If you specify that you just want paper one to be reviewed, you will pay once. The exact cost will be communicated to you once you have made a request for review of marking. If the grade changes, then you will receive a refund.

To request either access to script or review of marking you must fill in the form on the AGS website: The form will be available from results day.

You must fill in one form per qualification. An email will be sent to you within two days of your submission detailing how to pay and the cost. The price varies between the exam boards. Only once the payment has been received will the request be actioned. An email will be sent to you when we hear from the exam board with the decision. This can take up to 20 working days.

The deadline for all review of markings is Monday 21 September 2026. After this, no further requests can be submitted. This is a deadline set by all the exam boards.
