## Re Year 11 Transition Days Tuesday 16 and Wednesday 17 July 8.30am - 3.00pm

I am writing to invite your child to take part in our Year 11 transition days. This will be two days of events and activities to welcome students to Allerton Grange Sixth Form and to support them in making a good transition to Post 16 study.

The two transition days will take place on Tuesday 16 and Wednesday 17 July. Students will have a chance to experience the expert teaching provided by our Sixth Form teachers, with two lessons in each of their chosen subjects.

Throughout the two days, students will explore their possible career options, learn about the wide range of enrichment experiences that are offered, including Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), aspirational university choices and study skills workshops. They will also be able to enjoy a study period in the common room or a study space in our new facilities.

Year 11 will have the opportunity to meet with our head students to learn about sixth form life from a student's perspective and, at the end of the second day, there will be a social event for students to get to know each other.

## Arrangements for the day

- Arrival time 8.30am - please enter school via the student entrance (access from Talbot Avenue) and meet in the main hall.
- Break and Lunchtime - Allerton Grange students will be able to purchase food in their usual way, either via their account or free school meals. Please ensure they have sufficient funds in their ParentPay account if they wish to purchase food. Students can bring a packed lunch if preferred. External students will need to bring in their own food on both days. However, food will be available at the social event at the end of the second day. Sixth Form has cold drink and snacks vending machines which accepts contactless cards. Students will NOT be allowed to leave school to purchase food.
- Finish time 3.00pm - Students can make their own way home but if collected by parents please ensure you use the Lidgett Lane entrance.

Students will not need to wear school uniform but should follow the dress code expectations listed overleaf.
