Re: A Level Results Day – Thursday 13 August 2026

The A Level Results Day will be on Thursday 13 August 2026. I would like to thank you for your support throughout the examination period, and I look forward to celebrating the results with your child.

Students may collect their results from the main hall, between **8.00am until 12.00pm**, via the student entrance. There will be a careers adviser present on the day for those students who wish to receive further information following their results.

For those applying to higher education, students will be able to access their university offers on the morning of Thursday 13 August Via UCAS. This will inform them if they have been accepted, subject to meeting their offer entry requirements, for either their first or second choice universities. In the event that they do not meet the entry requirements, they may choose to enter the clearing process. Students must initiate this process as soon as possible and I recommend they come to school, at the earliest opportunity, so the Sixth Form team can support them with this.

Results will be emailed out to all students, via their school email addresses, at 12.00pm, regardless of whether or not they have collected them in person. If you do not receive the email on the day, please contact exams@allertongrange.com. It will not be possible for results to be given over the phone or to someone else on the student's behalf.
