# Re: A Level Results Day – Thursday 18 August 2022

The A Level Results Day will be on Thursday 18 August 2022. I would like to thank you for your support throughout the examination period, and I look forward to celebrating the results with your child on the day.

Students may collect their results at school from **8.00am until 12.00pm**. They should enter the building via the student entrance and collect their results from the main hall. There will be a careers advisor present on the day for those students who wish to receive further advice and guidance following their results.

For those students applying to higher education, they will be able to access their university offers on the morning of Thursday 18 August Via UCAS. This will inform them if they have been accepted, subject to meeting their offer entry requirements, for either their first or second choice universities. In the event that they do not meet the entry requirements, they may choose to enter the clearing process. Students must initiate this process as soon as possible and I recommend they come to school, at the earliest opportunity, so the Sixth Form team can support them with this.

Results will be emailed out to all students, via their school email addresses at 11.00am, regardless of whether or not they have collected their results in person. It will not be possible for results to be given over the phone or to someone else on the student's behalf.
