Re: Year 12 Enrichment trip to Liverpool - Tuesday 19 July 8.50am-approx 5.00pm

We are delighted to offer Year 12 the opportunity to visit Liverpool on Tuesday 19 July. Students will visit the Tate Liverpool Art Gallery in the morning, including a special exhibition entitled "Whose Tradition?", a look at cultural inspiration from around the world. In the afternoon, we will visit the International Slavery Museum and learn about Liverpool and England's history in the slave trade. Students will also have some free time during the day to explore the Royal Albert Dock and its related buildings.

On the day for registration, students should arrive in school at the earlier time of 8:30 and go straight to their form rooms, ready to leave school at 8:50am. We anticipate arriving back at school for approximately 5:00pm.

Students will be able to purchase lunch from one of the surrounding restaurants or cafes during their free exploration time.

Although we hope the weather will be kind, please ensure students are suitably dressed. A light coat will also be required in case of wet weather, and sun protection if the weather is hot.

The cost of the visit is £12, which includes travel and admission to both the Liverpool Tate Gallery and the International Slavery Museum. Payment will be required by Monday 6 June.

Students who receive the 16-19 Bursary Fund can claim the full cost of the trip from their bursary allocation. A packed lunch can also be provided for students who are in receipt of free school meals.

Please complete the permission slip attached and return it to your form tutor by Monday 6 June.

Please be aware it is your responsibility to inform the school of any changes to medical or contact information. Should your child require an inhaler, or other medication, please make sure they are in possession of it on the day of the trip, or they will not be allowed to attend.
