## Re: Year 12 Enrichment trip to Liverpool Thursday 18 July 2024

We are delighted to offer Year 12 students the opportunity to visit Liverpool on Thursday 18 July 2024. Students will visit the Walker Art Gallery, with special exhibits in a range of art forms and the International Slavery Museum to learn about Liverpool and England's history in the slave trade. Students will also have some free time during the day to explore the Royal Albert Docks.
