Dear Parent/Carer

Year 11 Study Leave

I would like to inform you that Year 11 will be on study leave with effect from Monday 11 May. During the study leave period, students should not be on the school site unless they are:

- Sitting an examination
- Attending a scheduled revision session
- On site by pre-arrangement with KS4 staff

Students who have examinations with a short break between them may remain on the school premises and revise quietly in a designated classroom. However, they must sign in at student entrance. Students attending any revision sessions must sign in and out via the Attendance door and record where they will be working.

We recognise that, in the lead-up to exams, some students may choose to revise at home. From 11 to 22 May, students may therefore revise independently at home or attend their usual timetabled lessons when they do not have an exam.

During this time, timetabled lessons will continue to run for students who wish to attend. During these sessions, teachers will deliver subject-specific revision lessons, and students must work on the subject being taught; revising other subjects during lessons will not be permitted.

Timetabled lessons will end on 22 May. After this date, students should only come into school for scheduled exams or if they have been specifically invited in for a particular reason.

To ensure they are comfortable during the examination period, we are allowing students to wear PE kit when attending examinations. This will be strictly enforced, and we expect students to maintain the school's high standards of conduct, co-operation, and behaviour throughout the study leave period.

Study leave is a privilege, and as such, the school reserves the right to withdraw it for any individual who abuses this arrangement or fails to meet school or examination obligations.



We ask that every student uses this time positively. To support independent revision at home, curriculum areas have prepared a range of resources and materials, which are available via Class Charts and the Allerton Grange School website.

Year 11 Leavers' Assembly

Students are invited into school for the Year 11 Leavers' Assembly at 2.00 pm on Thursday 25 June. They must enter via the student entrance and will be escorted to the hall for the assembly. This is an opportunity to say farewell to staff and peers while also celebrating students' achievements throughout their time at Allerton Grange School. They will then be dismissed from the school site by 3.00pm.

Year 11 Prom

The Year 11 Prom will take place on Friday 26 June at The Village Hotel, starting at 7.00 pm and concluding by 11.00 pm. Tickets are available to purchase on Parent Pay until 15 May, at a cost of £40 which includes a buffet and soft drinks. We look forward to celebrating with students at this event.
