Complex	The student has clear and complex knowledge and fulfils most/all expectations of the curriculum so far. The student can confidently explain the different responses that we have looked at this term. They can identify and explain the strengths and weaknesses of these Ideas and can confidently identify who would agree with these responses and why.
