School attendance

All students are expected to attend registration every day at 8.30am, and to maintain an attendance of above 95% at all times. They must attend all of the lessons on their timetable, arriving punctually, but are allowed to leave the school site during their non-contact periods. If you wish to report your child's absence please do so via classcharts as soon as possible.

Dress code



While students have the freedom of a less restricted dress code than the rest of the school, Allerton Grange Sixth Form is still a place of learning within a school community. This means that business like attire is more appropriate for this setting, based on the dress code below:

- Skirts and shorts should be of an appropriate length ie knee length
- Midriffs should not be visible
- Discreet facial piercings are permitted
- Lanyards must be worn at all times.

If a student is found to be in breach of these guidelines, they will be asked to go home to change.
