As we look to prepare our students for life beyond Allerton Grange, we are providing a valuable work experience week for students, to find out more about the work place, specific jobs, and to develop their employability skills. We also hope that this will help to motivate them and raise their aspirations.

The Allerton Grange work experience week is taking place between 10-14 July 2023. I'm sure you can appreciate how much work is involved in ensuring placements are secured, safety checked and quality assured for over 150 students.
